Jellyfish Prewriting Craft



What you'll need:

- Piece of white paper
- Markers or crayons
- Scissors

Directions:

- 1. Draw a large curve on the white piece of paper, starting at the very bottom of the paper, spanning the whole page
- 2. Draw a wavy line ⅓ of the way down from the top of the curve to make the jellyfish head
- 3. Add eyes and a mouth on the head of the jellyfish
- 4. Lightly color in the head of the jellyfish with any preferred color
- 5. Starting at the wavy line, draw 4-5 straight, vertical lines down to the bottom of the page (these are the lines you will be cutting on)
- 6. Add various types of lines to fill the entirety of the bottom section (i.e. dotted lines, wavy lines, jagged lines, curly lines, etc.)
- 7. Cut out the large curve
- 8. Cut out the 4-5 vertical lines, starting at the bottom of the page and cutting up to the bottom of the jellyfish head
- 9. Starting at the bottom of each strip, fold ∼½ in. in an alternating pattern, creating a wavy look

Ways to increase difficulty:

- Have the child come up with different types of lines on their own
- Cut wavy lines rather than straight vertical lines
- Have the child work from the photo instead of providing verbal/visual step-by-step directions, to increase ability to work from a model

Ways to decrease difficulty:

- Provide the child with an initial outline of a curve rather than having them draw it
- Provide yellow lines for the child to trace on
- Cut out the curve for the child if they have difficulty cutting rounded sides
