
Reach for the Stars! Gross Motor/Visual Motor Activity



What you'll need:

- Party streamers
- Construction paper (4 different colors)
- Tape
- 4 paper plates

Directions:



- 1. Cut 4 stars on each sheet of construction paper. You will have 16 stars in total, consisting of 4 different colors. 12 stars will be used for the streamers. The remaining 4 will be used for the paper plates (be sure they are all a different color).
- 2. Rip 12 strips of party streamers. The strips will need to be long enough to hang from the ceiling, with the bottom being in close reach of the child.
- 3. Tape a star to the end of each streamer and then tape the streamers to the ceiling.
- 4. Tape a star to each paper plate.
- 5. Place the paper plates on the floor, a few feet away from the hanging streamers.
- 6. The main objective of the game is to reach for one star at a time and place it on the corresponding paper plate.
- 7. Encourage the child to use one hand to hold the bottom of the streamer and one hand to pull off the star. This will promote bilateral coordination.
- 8. Continue until all of the stars are sorted on their respective plates.

Ways to increase difficulty:

- Place the streamers higher above the child to increase the reach demand.
- Incorporate a midline cross when reaching for the star.
- Time how long it takes the child to complete the activity. Have them try to beat their time or compete against siblings or friends!

Ways to decrease difficulty:

- Allow the child to pull the entire streamer down if they are having difficulty using two hands to retrieve the star.
- Reduce the amount of colors or number of stars being used in activity.
