

Superhero Clothespins

This activity is a fun way to promote hand dexterity and strengthening. These skills help us be able to manipulate objects and perform more precise movements with our hands!

What you'll need:

- Wooden clothespins
- Card stock or construction paper (any colors of choice)
- Markers
- Glue
- Printer paper
- Scissors

Directions:

1. Glue the pre-cut paper triangles to the bottom of the clothespin (the tip of the triangle should be facing the same way as the 'head' of the superhero).
2. Glue the pre-cut smaller rectangles to the front of the clothespin (should be gluing onto the 'head' of the superhero). This will be the mask.
3. Use a marker to draw eyes and a mouth onto the clothespin.
4. Repeat as desired.

Ways to increase difficulty:

- Have your child cut the cardstock/paper themselves
- Have your child color/paint the clothespin

Ways to decrease difficulty:

- Have an image of the completed activity beside the child for visual reference while completing activity.
- Have only the materials for each step at a time visually available until that step is completed.
