Prewriting and Cutting Fish Craft


What you'll need:

- Piece of white paper
- Colored paper of your choice
- Markers or crayons
- Scissors**
- Glue

**Use caution when handling scissors with young children. Use child-safe scissors, supervision, or do the cutting for them, as needed. **

Directions:

- 1. Draw a large fish on a white piece of paper, spanning the whole page
- 2. Add eyes and a mouth on the head of the fish
- 3. Lightly color in the head of the jellyfish with any preferred color
- 4. Using colored paper, draw small shapes that will be the fish scales
- 5. Cut out the scales
- 6. Paste the scales on the fish as desired
- 7. Complete the fish by adding any designs with crayons/markers



Ways to increase difficulty:

- Have the child come up with the fish shapes and draw it themselves
- Encourage wavy lines rather than straight vertical lines
- Have the child cut the scales in a variety of shapes
- Have the child cut out the fish at the end

Ways to decrease difficulty:

- Provide the child with an initial outline of a fish that they can trace
- Provide highlighted lines for child to cut the scales out on
- Stick to cutting straight lines rather than curved ones
