
# Muddy Pig Sensory Art

This activity is a great way for children to receive sensory input without the mess of typical sensory play!





#### What you'll need:

- Pig printable (provided below)
- Gallon-size bag sealable plastic bag
- Shaving cream
- Brown washable paint
- Green construction paper (optional)
- Glue (optional)

## **Directions:**

- 1. Place the cut out pig printable in the gallon bag
- 2. Add shaving cream and brown paint into the bag on top of the pig printout
- 3. Seal the plastic bag
- 4. Have the child pat and rub the paint and shaving cream around the bag, fully covering the pig
- 5. Pull the pig out of the bag and let dry
- 6. If desired, glue the pig onto a piece of green construction paper

## Ways to increase difficulty:

- Have the child squirt the shaving cream and paint into the bag to work on hand strength
- Create a barnyard scene on the green construction paper before gluing the pig

## Ways to decrease difficulty:

• Provide hand over hand assistance with patting or rubbing motions
