Galaxy Slime







Single Color Recipe

What you'll need:

- 8 oz. of Elmer's glitter glue of choice (black, blue, purple, or silver; clear can be used if desired)
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 4 tsp. ReNu contact solution

Directions:

- 1. Combine glitter glue and baking soda in a bowl.
- 2. Add contact solution to the glitter glue and baking soda mixture.
- 3. Continue stirring until slime starts to form.
- 4. If the slime is still sticky, remove the slime from the bowl and begin to knead.
- 5. If using plain clear glue, add glitter to slime if desired.

Four Color Recipe

What you'll need:

- 2 oz. of Elmer's black glitter glue
- 2 oz. of Elmer's purple glitter glue
- 2 oz. of Elmer's blue glitter glue
- 2 oz. of Elmer's clear glitter glue
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 4 tsp. ReNu contact solution

Directions:

- 1. Combine 2 oz. of glitter glue with ¼ tsp. of baking soda.
- 2. Add 1 tsp. of contact solution to the glitter glue and baking soda mixture.
- 3. Continue stirring until slime starts to form.
- 4. If the slime is still sticky, remove the slime from the bowl and begin to knead.
- 5. Repeat steps 1-4 for each remaining glue color.
- 6. When all 4 slime colors have been made, lay colors out side by side, as seen in the picture at the top of this sheet.
- 7. Pull and twist the slime to create a beautiful galaxy!

Ways to increase difficulty:

- Have the child measure out the ingredients independently.
- Have the child follow the recipe independently.

Ways to decrease difficulty:

- Have the ingredients pre-measured and ready for combination.
- Provide hand-over-hand assistance for pouring and stirring.
