

# Flower Sensory Bottle



## What you'll need:

- Plastic water bottle or container
- Rocks / pebbles
- Water
- Glitter (green preferred)
- Funnel
- Construction paper or flower stickers
- Scissors
- Marker
- Glue
- Foam sheets and hot glue gun (for upgraded activity only)

## Directions:

1. Draw flower patterns on construction paper and cut them out.
2. Glue paper flowers onto plastic bottle for decoration.
  - If using stickers instead, choose stickers and place around plastic bottle for decoration.
3. Fill  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the plastic bottle with rocks / pebbles.
4. Fill rest of plastic bottle with water. Add 2-3 shakes of glitter. Close bottle tight.

## Ways to increase difficulty:

- Replace construction paper with foam sheets to draw and cut the flower - this is a more difficult material to manipulate and cut.

## Ways to decrease difficulty:

- Have all materials measured and ready so your child can assemble independently.

- Draw and cut out flower patterns for your child so they can just focus on glueing onto the bottle.
