
Helicopter Craft



What you'll need:

- Card stock: light blue
- Colored paper: red, orange, white
- Popsicle sticks
- Cotton balls
- Black marker
- Glue: stick and white liquid glue
- Scissors**

**Use caution with scissors and sharps around children, do the cutting for them if necessary.

Directions:

- 1. On the orange paper, draw a circle and rectangle for the helicopter base
- 2. On the red paper draw a triangle
- 3. On the white paper draw a window (it should look like a triangle with one rounded side).
- 4. Cut out all the above shapes.
- 5. Using the glue stick, glue the parts of the helicopter on the cardstock as shown in the picture.
- 6. Take 2-3 cotton balls and stretch them out slightly with your hands
- 7. Glue the cotton ball "clouds" wherever you'd like in the "sky".
- 8. Using the liquid glue, glue one popsicle stick above the front of the helicopter, in a diagonal line.
- 9. Add a big blob of glue onto the middle of that stick, and place the second popsicle stick to create an "X".

- 10. Draw a line from the center of the popsicle sticks to connect them to the helicopter.
- 11. Draw 2 lines coming out of the bottom of the helicopter and connect them with a horizontal line to create the landing skids.
- 12. Have fun with your helicopter and see where it can take you!

To increase difficulty:

- Have your child cut the helicopter parts out on white paper and color them in.
- Add a pilot in the window

To decrease difficulty:

- Trace the shapes for your child on the colored paper
- Place pencil dots in the places your child should glue all the parts
